This year we celebrate the 10th annual Canoe Carry from Little Machias Lake to Portage Lake. BUILDING FUND UPDATE

In 2016, the PL Historical Society entered into an agreement to purchase the Old Town Hall building on Cottage Road from Daniel Higgins Sr. for \$40,000. At the end of this summer, he will have been paid a total of \$10,000 toward the purchase of the building. Currently, there is \$12,000 in the Building Fund bank account, mostly from generous donors. If a person or business donates at least \$25 toward the fund. they will have their name on a plague on display in the entrance of the Old Town Hall when it becomes our museum! 
