

**Public Hearing for CDBG for Wildlife Artistry
Portage Lake Municipal Building
Tuesday July 9, 2019**

Hearing called to order at 6:00 p.m. by David Pierce, Selectboard chairman

There were 13 people in attendance.

The purpose of the public hearing is to allow public comment on acceptance of funds for a CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) Micro Enterprise Program, having been awarded to Wildlife Artistry taxidermy for the total amount of \$50,000.

Public Discussion:

Steve Jandreau, owner of Wildlife Artistry, explains that his plans are to expand his building to create a bigger work/display area, to change the roof pitch to help in the winter months, and to create handicap access to his business. Joella Theriault, from NMDC, said the funding will be available for distribution on September 1. She said Phase 1 was to receive the award, which has been completed, and Phase 2 is waiting for the environmental reports to come in. The contract is made with the Town and the money passes through the Town as needed.

There were no other public comments or questions.
