

A brief rundown of the 1984 Planning Board meetings follows:

2/3/84 The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Chairman Roland Caron.

A model of what a planning board should consist of was presented by Chairman Caron. New "Planning Boards and Home Rule" statute (enacted in 1971) was discussed.

The Planning Board discussed duties and responsibilities and decided that seven members with no alternates would be appropriate for the Town of Portage. The following terms were designated for each member:
