

Selectmen's Meeting Feb. 5, 1987.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. By Chairman Leo Cormier. Those present included Selectmens Leo Cormier, Dan Higgins, Hebe Umphrey and Town Manager Paul Blanchette. Mr. & Mrs. Peter St. Peter were present.

1) The Town Manager was asked to ask DEP for more money for septic systems.

2) Bids were received from Shamrock Logging and Construction and from Portage Construction for Six systems.

It was decided to award five systems to Shamrock and to award the Levesque system to Portage Const.

3) Snowmobile Grant guarantee was okayed. Letter from club certifying the necessary funds will be on hand acceptable.

4) Leo moved and Hebe seconded a motion that the town open the Gulf Course Road for recreation purposes. Dan voiced his disagreement. Motion carried 2 to 1

4) It was moved and seconded that an article be placed in Town warrant for \$500.00 scholarship.

5) Town Manager presented budget to Selectmen for 1987. It was moved and seconded that the Town Manager's salary be 16,500.00 for 1987.

It was moved and seconded that William Good's wages be raised by 5%.

After some discussion, the Selectmen approved the budget with a change in the Hot Topping account. This account was decreased by 15,000.00 to 15,000.00. All other accounts stayed the same.

6) The following people were nominated for the Budget Committee:

Selectmen's Meeting
03-02-87

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Leo Cormier. Those present included Selectmen Leo Cormier, Daniel Higgins, Heber Umphrey, and Town Manager Paul Blanchette.

- 1) The Town Manager presented the board of Selectmen with a copy of the annual Town Meeting Warrent. The Board reviewed the warrent. The Manager explained to the Board the reasons behind the article to change the elected Town's Clerk to an appointed one. It was pointed out that Mrs. Cote had indicated that this would be her last year as clerk. The position of Town Clerk is one that now entails much work and dedication. An individual that is best suited for the job should be selected for it. It was also pointed out that this would not go into effect until next year if it is passed. The Board okayed this article but he recommended that the wording be changed to read "To see if the Town will vote to change the position of the Town Clerk from an elected one to one that is appointed."
- 2) The Board reviewed the rest of the Town report before it went to press. The Town Report was approved.
- 3) A discussion was held to see if the Town Report would be dedicated to anyone. It was the concensus of the Board that the report not be dedicated to any individual.
- 4) The Manager asked the Board of Selectmen if they would be in favor of renting the municipal building for receptions. The Board replied that they would be in favor of renting the building provided that the Town would not face any additional liability. They asked the Town Manager to check into insurance and other liability. The Board asked the Manager to draw up a rental agreement for their approval.
- 5) Nashville Plantation and their use of the dump was discussed. The Manager was asked to check with Nashville to find out which resident's of Nashville use the dump. It was decided to look for a increased dump fee from Nashville for next year.

Leo moved to adjourn at 8:30 P.M.
Hebe seconded the motion.

3) The Board of Selectmen decided that Dump hours would be 8-5 Sat *Summer hours*
9-6 Mon *Summer hours*
8-5 Sat + Mon *winter hours*

- 4) Gulf Course liquor application was signed.
Gun permit for Mike Harvilic was signed.

5) Resolutions for Budget Committee and for the Speakers Committee on Property tax reform were signed.

6) The Town Manager was asked to prepare a rental agreement for the Municipal Building for the approval of the selectmen.

7) The Town Manager told the selectmen that push bars would be necessary for the exit doors on the Municipal building.

8) The Manager informed the selectmen of the appraisal done on the old town hall. The appraisal is being forwarded to NMRPC in order to obtain a release from the federal government.

9) It was moved by Dan and Seconded by Hebe that diesel fuel and heating oil be put out to bid on a yearly basis. all were in agreement.

10) The Manager informed the Board of the need of five new grills for the beach area. The selectmen agreed.

11) The Manager informed the Board that he had checked with state surplus a generator to run the steam cleaner but that they had none on hand at the present and that they would keep Portage in mind when they found some. It was suggested that the manager check with Loring for their surplus.

12) The Manager informed the Board that there would be a need for a special town meeting due to a flood ordinance that requires some action. Leo informed the board that thye would have his resignation by then.

It was moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan to adjourn. Length 1½ hours.

Selectmen's Meeting
April 15, 1987

Those present included Selectmens Hebe Umphrey, Dan Higgins, Town Manager Paul Blanchette, Patty Levesque, Pam Potter, and Mr. and Mrs. Robert Cyr.

Chairman Umphrey called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

1) Patty Levesque was present to talk about the aerobic classes she had been having at the old town hall. She had been advised by the Town Manager that the old building would no longer be available for public use and that the Selectmen had decided to charge her \$20.00/week for the use of the new center. Mrs. Levesque indicated that she thought that this was too much money. She is currently paying \$30.00/month for the use of the rec center in Ashland. Mrs. Levesque offered the Town of Portage \$30.00/month for the use of the Municipal Center for three evenings per week (Mon., Wed., and Friday) each class to last from 6:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. The Board of Selectmen accepted her offer.

2) The minutes of the March 2, 1987 were read. It was moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan that the minutes be accepted as read.

The dump was discussed. The Town Manager was asked to remind Zenon that the dump was for the use of Portage and Nashville residents only. The tire pile should be relocated to the other side of the dump. Hebe informed the Town that the fire warden for the area was Tommy Martin.

3) The minutes of the April 1, 1987 meeting were read. It was moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan that the minutes be accepted as read.

4) It was moved by Dan and seconded by Hebe to appoint Mac Nasson to the Planning Board with his term of office to expire in 1990.

5) The rental agrrement for the Municipal center was reviewed and accepted. It was moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan that the rental fee be \$75.00 for the use of the Municipal Center and \$25.00 for the use of the Kitchen. Organizations will pay for the use of the building when they are holding a money making event.

6) The Manager told the board that the Town Sign would be put up on the south end of town in the near future. The other sign needs to be redone and would be brought to Donna Howes in Ashland.

7) A letter of resignation from Selectman Leo Cormier was presented to the Board. It was moved by Dan and seconded by Hebe to accept the resignation.

8) The Manager informed the Board that a special Town Meeting would be needed in early June to deal with a flood plain ordinance. This would be coordinated with the School Budget and an election for the vacant position of Selectmen if at all possible.

Hebe moved to adjourn. Dan Seconded the motion.

Selectmen's Meeting May 6, 1987.

Those present included Selectmen Hebe Umphrey, Dan Higgins, Town Manager Paul Blanchette, and John Kozloff.

Chairman Umphrey called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

1) The minutes of the April 15, 1987 meeting were read. It was moved by Dan and seconded by Hebe to accept the minutes as read.

2) Sweeper for Plow Truck- The Manager asked the Selectmen to consider purchasing a new sweeper for the plow truck as the present sweeper is in rough shape. A new sweeper would cost between \$3,000.00 and \$3500.00. The Selectmen decided to table this until they are able to look at the old sweeper. *at 6:00 on 1st + Third Weds.*

3) Seaplane Base- The Selectmen decided to not have the floats put until the pier was fixed. It was decided to fix the floats and to put them on cedar blocks to protect them.

The Manager informed the Selectmen that there was a holdup with Agusta in that a DEP Permit may have to be obtained before the repair of the pier could be made. The Selectmen dicussed various ways of repairing the pier.

4) The Manager told the selectmen that a request had been received from the Niles Jandreau family for the use of the Municipal building to hold a yard sale to raise money for their daughter for use as an exchange student. The selectmen stayed with the policy that any organization that used the building for a money maker should pay for the use of the building.

5) Septic Systems- Manager informed the Board that a DEP Representative would be here on the 28th of May to look at other systems for replacements. These systems would be replaced on a basis as money was available.

John Kozloff asked about the trees that were left along the West Cottage Road while the Bugbee system was being installed. Dan assured him that these would be removed in the near future.

6) Manager informed the Board that he was taking a vacation and would be back on the twenty-sixth of May. Gladys Cote would be replacing him for that time period.

7) The Board was informed that a public hearing is going to be held on the 14th of May for the Flood plain ordinance.

8) The Manager was asked to obtain discount prices from Coffin's and the Portage Trading Post for the purchase of gas for town equipment.

Dan moved to adjourn, Hebe seconded. Length of meeting 1½hr.

Selectmen's Meeting June 3, 1987.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. Those present included Selectmen Heber Umphrey, Daniel Higgins, Paul Blanchette, Town Manager, and Marcel Theriault.

- 1) The minutes of the last meeting, May 6, 1987, were read and accepted as read.
- 2) The manager informed the board that he had had a request from George Gray asking that the unused portion of the Jim Garriety permit to cut wood on Town Land be transferred to him. The Board asked the Town Manager to talk to Jim and Eugene Morris to find out the status of this permit. There was also some brief discussion about not cutting any more on that tract of property.
- 3) Marcel Theriault asked about an easement from the town to him on the Gulf Course property to property that he is buying from Gilbert Cyr. The Town Manager was asked to check with an attorney as to whether or not the Town could grant such an easement since the land is leased to the Gulf Course.
- 4) Revaluation- The Town Manager informed the Board that he had asked three other firms, besides Scott Appraisals, to give an estimate of costs for a Town revaluation. Only one firm gave an estimate, Patten Appraisals. The estimate was for \$30,000.00. Scott's price was for \$16,100.00. The Selectmen signed the agreement with Scott.
- 5) A release deed for Stevens was signed. Warrents were signed.
- 6) Rear Parking area- The Manager talked about expanding the rear parking area. Approval was granted.
- 7) The Manager reported to the Selectmen that Portage Trading Post was willing to give the Town a 3% discount on Gas. Coffins was not willing to give a discount.
- 8) DEP letters were read to the Selectmen. DEP granted approval for three more systems, Bragdon, Martin, and Gribetz. Also, Dean's has until July 30, 1987 to straighten out the land problem.
- 9) Campground- A sign limiting stay to ten days is posted. Would the Town be willing to lease the Campgroun area? Selectmen are split on this issue. Hebe is in favor of the Town retaining control.
- 10) The manager was asked to come up with a set of guidelines for building permits. The Selectmen suggested that doubling the fee for permits after the fact was in order.

Hebe moved to adjourn. Dan Seconded the motion. Length 1 hr.

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Selectmen's Meeting July 1, 1987

The meeting was called to order at 6:10 P. M. Those present included Selectmen Heber Umphrey, Dan Higgins, Town Manager Paul Blanchette and George Gray, newly elected selectmen, not yet sworn in.

- 1) The minutes of the last meeting were read and accepted as read. (6/3/87)
- 2) Easement for Marcel Theriault- It was moved by hebe and seconded by Dan that the town along with the Gulf course grant an easement to Marcel Theriault.
- 3) Church use of Municipal- The manager indicated to the selectmen that there had been som questions raised as to the use of the Municipal Building by the Bible Church. The Selectmen's position on this issue is that this Country founded for religous freedom and that as long as the use of the building did not interfere with municipal use there was no problem. Also, most of the people using the building were tax payers in Portage.
- 4) Camping area- New policy- Once a statemnet as to the use of the area has been made, it can only be changed by the Selectmen in a Selectmen's meeting.
- 5) Diesel Storage-- The manager informed the board that our diesel could be stored with an earthen dam.
- 6) Planning Board- The manager informed the board that the planning board was going to start meeting to redo portions of the Town Ordinance.
- 7) Garriety Wood permit- Manager brought the Selectmen up to date on this issue. Jim wants to retain the permit for his use. Selectmen a discussed the possibility of not doing any more cutting of that piece of land.
- 8) School Budget-The manager informed the Board on the current status of the school budget.
- 9) Plow Truck- The Manager informed the Board that the newer of the plow trucks had a serious oil leak and that it probably was time to have a motor job on it. Hebe offered to talk to MPG and to get a price on this.
- 10) Septic System for Municipal Building- The manager informed the Board that the septic system at the municipal building had stopped working. David Chasse has been called to pump it.
- 11) State Value- The propsed State valuation for Portage Lake is ^{10,000}~~15,450~~, an increase of less then ⁴~~5~~%. The average increase for the surrounding towns is 6½%.

Hebe moved to adjourn. Dan Seconded the motion.

Special Selectmen's Meeting 7/10/87

Those present included Selectmen Hebe Umphrey, George Gray, Dan Higgins, Town Manager Paul Blanchette, School Board Memebers Lance Hayward, Mike Bartlett, Carol Gagnon, Supt. Greg Botka, Greg Cyr, and John Martinz.

This meeting was held at the request of the Portage School Board members. It focused on the School Budget. The school board members answered question about the proposed budget and the state of affairs of the school.

The Portage Board of Selectmen decided not to oppose the proposed budget in any way. It was decided that the town would not send out any letters to the people advising them of the upcomming meetings as the school district had already done so.

Meeting adjourned at 7:00 P.M. Length of meeting 1 hr.

the meeting was called to order at 6:07 P.M. by Chairman Umphrey. Those present included Selectmen Hebe Umphrey, George Gray, town Manager Paul Blanchette, guests Sarah Brooks, Mike Luchetti, Chris Fish, and Selectmen Dan Higgins at 6:30.

- 1) Sarah Brooks and Mike Luchetti spoke on what they are attempting to do with their business and on how they are promoting the Portage Lake area.
- 2) Chris Fish spoke to the Selectmen on the conditions found on his neighbors property, Elsie Cormier. The Town Manager informed the Board that Mrs. Cormier had been sent a registered letter telling her to clean up around her property. The Town Manager and the Health officer are to inspect the property to see if Mrs. Cormier has complied with the letter.
- 3) The minutes of the July 1, 1987 meeting and the Special meeting on July 10 were read. It was moved by Hebe and seconded by George to accept these minutes as read.
- 4) Ullmen property- The manager told the Selectmen that he had had a request from a Mr. Ulman on the value of his property. The selectmen agreed that the value was high. It was moved by Dan and seconded by Hebe that the value be decreased by 1600 dollars for this year pending the results of the ongoing revaluation. The Manager is to inform Mr. Ulman.
- 5) Gulf Course exemption- The Board clarified this exemption to say that the exemption is only in force until such a time the Golf Course is on a sound financial footing. The Manager was asked to send a letter to the Golf Course stating the position of the Board.
- 6) Herb McPherson- Mr. McPherson asked if the ditch project next to his home was completed. He was told that it wasn't done as of yet.
- 7) It was moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan that the Town should buy a new sweeper for the truck. The sweeper to be bought is a Frink from H.P. Fairfield. The Manager was directed to sell the old sweeper if possible. All selectmen agreed.
- 8) Office help- The Manager asked the Board to consider getting office help now in order to train someone to replace Gladys Cote as Town Clerk. The Manager was given the okay to interview for the position.
- 9) Sea Plane base update- The manager informed the Board that he had been in touch with the D.O.T. Someone for the dept will be in the area shortly to look into the problem.
- 10) Cemetary- After a brief discussion on the new cemetary, it was moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan to hire a surveyor to lay out the cemetary.
- 11) The Manager inform the board that the town truck was at the MPG garage for a motor job.
- 4A) The manager brought up the subject about land for a proposed elderly housing complex. He suggested that the Town Land on the West side would be a good place for the project. It was moved by George and Seconded by Hebe that the selectmen give an option to Voisine and Higgins, pending a special town meeting to okay the sale of land, on 4 acres of land to be used for an elderly housing complex only. It is the intent of the Board of Selectmen to allow Voisine and Higgins the right of first refusal should the town vote to sell the land.

Selectmen's Meeting 9-16-87.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. Those present included Selectman Heber Umphrey, Dan Higgins, George Gray, and Town Manager Paul Blanchette.

1) The minutes of the Aug. 5, 1987 meeting were read. It was moved by Dan and seconded by Hebe to accept the minutes as read.

2) Cemetary- The board was told that no surveyor was hire because the cemetary had already been surveyed. All that needs to be done is to find the cornnor posts.

3) Old Town Hall- The manager informed the board that preliminary indications were that the building could be sold with out returning any money to the Federal Government.

A discussion about the area lights around the building was had. It was moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan to have the two area lights removed as soon as possible.

4) Ashland Area Recreation- The manager informed the Board that he had recieved a letter from the Ashland Rec Program asking if the Town of Portage Lake would be willing to pickup part of the tab for percentage of the Portage people that used the program. The board declined to do this. The manager was asked to send a letter to the Ashland Rec to inform them of the Board's decision.

5) Basketball Hoops- The manager asked the board to okay the purchase of two portable basketball goals for use in the Municipal building. The Board agreed to the purchase. The board suggested that before the hoops could be used the windows in the area would have to be covered.

6) The Manager informed the Board that he had had a request from Dan Higgins about Higgins purchasing some ledge from the Town at the end of the East Cottage Rd. Higgins would have some 500 yards of ledge pushed up, he would then reloam and seed the area. In addition he would pay the Town 50¢/ Yard for the Ledge. Selectmans Umphrey and Gray agreed to letting Higgins purchase the ledge provided that the area was fixed up after ward.

7) The Selectmen signed warrents, septic sludge agreements and a deed for Donald Belanger.

8) A discussion on the Town Hall Rental was had. The board policy on charging non-profit organizations rent for the use of the building for fund raisers for themselves was discussed. Higgins and Umphrey were in favor of leaving the policy alone while Gray was infavor of changing the policy to allow the non-propfit organizations to use the building at no fee or at a reduced fee.

Dan moved to adjourn at 7:00 P.M. George seconded the motion

2) Snowmobile Club and Town Hall Rental- There was a discussion on the amount of rental the snowmobile club would have to pay if they were to use the Town Hall for a benefit for themselves. The Town Manager read the the Town's policy as set by the Selectmen in April of 1987 concerning the the Town Hall rental. It was moved by Dan and seconded by Hebe the the Town Hall be rented to the Snowmobile Club for fifty dollars, including the use of the Kitchen, plus a deposit of \$75.00 to be returned if the Hall is left in order.

3) The Manager read a letter from the Snowmobile Club concerning their financial condition. The Manager suggested that the Town guarantee the Clubs portion of the 1987 Snowmobile grant with out requireing the club to have that amount in their checking account. It was move by Hebe and seconded by Dan that the Town guarantee the club's portion of the grant.

4)Septic Bids- Bids for four septic systems were recieved from three contractorss and were opened. Demercharnt Const. was awarded the contracts for Deans and Bragdons. Portage Const was awarded the contract for the Martin system. Shamrock const. was awarded the contract for the Gribetz system.

5) town Sherriff- The Manager asked the Board how long they wished to keep Richard Martin on weekends. He told the board that there was enough money for another 4 weeks. It was moved by Dan and seconded by Hebe that Richar be kept until the end of the Hunting season. It was also moved by Dan and seconded by Hebe the twon Manager send a letter to the Sherriff's Dept. complimenting Richard for a job well done.

6) Planning Board- The Manager read a letter form the Planning Board suggesting that the Selectmen look into selling som e of the Town properties, namely the old Town Hall, the Sea Plane Base area, The campground, and the 27 acreas along the West Cottage Rd. The selectmen agreed to have an article drawn up for the next town meeting to cover this.

Warrents were signed.

It was moved by Hebe and seconded by George that the meeting be adjourned. Length of meeting was 1½ hours.

Selectmen's Meeting Oct. 21, 1987

Those present included Selectmen Hebe Umphrey, Dan Higgins, George GRay, and Town Manager Paul Blanchette.

Chairman Umphrey called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

- 1) The minutes of the Oct 7, 1987 meeting were read. It was moved by Hebe and seconded by George to accept them as read.
- 2) Cemetary- The Town Manager reccommended to the Selectmen that the town take over the responsibility of the openning and the closing of graves at the rate of \$150.00 per burial to avoid confussion in the cemetary. It was moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan that this be done. All were in agreement.
- 3) The Town Manager told the Board that final premission had been recieved from the Federal Government through NMRPC for the town to get rid of the Old Town Hall. It was moved by Dan and seconded by George that an article be placed in the annual town meeting to recieve premission from the Town's people in order to place the old town hall and other Town Properties as reccommended by the planning board out to bid.

Hebe moved to adjourn. Dan seconded the motion.

Selectmen's Meeting Nov. 18, 1987

Those present included Selectmen Hebe Umphrey, Dan Higgins, George Gray, and Town Manager Paul Blanchette.

Chairman Umphrey called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

- 1) The minutes of the Oct. 21, Meeting were read. It was moved by Dan and Seconded by George to accept the minutes as read.
- 2) The Manager told the board that he would be attending workshops for vehicle registration and for the dump on Dec. 9 & 10 in Augusta.
- 3) Cloukeys- The Manager informed the Board that the well at the Cloukey residence was polluted by the new septic system put in last fall. The system sits on ledge and goes into the well. It was moved by Hebe, seconded by Dan that a new well be put in. It was also moved by Hebe and seconded by Dan that a five hundred dollar charge be added to all septic contracts in the future to cover such incidents.
- 4) The Manager informed the Board that a salt-sand storage shed would have to be built by 1992.
- 5) The Selectmen were shown the dump priority list compiled by the state.
- 6) Hebe asked that an article for the rental of the Town Hall be placed in the warrant for the annual Town Meeting. This is in response to people who feel that the Town is charging too much for the use of the Building.
- 7) The manager was asked to talk to Helen Jones about the glass breakage at the dump and the roll of her children in the breakage.
